

**MEMORANDUM OF ARTICULATION
BETWEEN
The Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the
University of Missouri-Kansas City Honors College
And
St. Charles Community College Honors Program**

OVERVIEW:

This formal program articulation agreement is made and entered into by the Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University of Missouri-Kansas City Honors College (hereinafter referred to as UMKC) and St. Charles Community College Honors Program (hereinafter referred to as SCC). By this agreement SCC and UMKC express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to and success in higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures which assure articulation between programs, the institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transition when transferring from one institution to the other.

PURPOSE:

This agreement facilitates the transfer of highly qualified students from St. Charles Community College's Honors Program to UMKC's Honors College.

CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

Section I: Admission & Matriculation

The catalog year and related graduation requirements for students falling under this agreement will be determined based upon their first term of enrollment at UMKC. UMKC will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to transfer students as those applicable to native students at UMKC.

Transfer applicants must complete their application for admission to UMKC and their UMKC Honors College application prior to the respective deadline for each application. Application deadline information may be found in the University Catalog - <https://catalog.umkc.edu/colleges-schools/honors-college/>.

SCC Honors Program students with a cumulative transfer GPA of 3.7 or higher will automatically be admissible to the UMKC Honors College.

SCC Honors Program students with a cumulative transfer GPC below 3.7 will be admissible to the UMKC Honors College provided their Honors College application is accompanied by a letter of support from the SCC Honors Program Director affirming the student is a member in good standing of the SC Honors Program.

Transfer students are encouraged to apply by the priority application date to ensure consideration for the greatest amount of financial aid and scholarships. Aid opportunities and priority application date information may be found here - <http://finaid.umkc.edu/>.


Section II: Transfer of Credit Hours

A maximum of 9 honors credit hours will be accepted by UMKC from SCC to be applied to honors credit hours required for graduation with University Honors from the UMKC Honors College. Transferred honors coursework must have a minimum grade of B to count toward the University Honors graduation requirement.




