The form must be received by the application deadline, which is set ONE SEMESTER PRIOR TO the anticipated degree completion date. (LATE APPLICATIONS will be accepted through the first week of classes for May and August candidates. A \$20 penalty fee will be charged.) The application fee is non-refundable.**

**Students who fail to apply for graduation during the "late application" period will be charged a fee of \$100 .**

**COMPLETE A SEPARATE APPLICATION FOR EACH DEGREE/CERTIFICATE YOU ARE APPLYING FOR. THE COST FOR EACH ADDITIONAL DEGREE (EARNED IN THE SAME SEMESTER) IS \$10 EACH.**

**A commencement ceremony is held each May. Graduates from the previous December and March and candidates for May and August graduation are invited to attend. There is no additional fee to participate in the ceremony. December, March, and May diplomas will be mailed to the graduate's home within three weeks after the May ceremony. August diplomas will be mailed to the graduate's home three weeks after the end of the summer term. Information regarding the commencement ceremony will be mailed to your home in March. Each candidate is required to be measured for a cap and gown. Measuring will take place at the SCC Bookstore. The dates for measuring will be mailed to you. Please check for notices posted in the academic hallways or call the Bookstore at 636-922-8431.**

**This application may be transferred (without an additional fee) to a future term by contacting the Office of the Registrar in writing. THIS MUST BE DONE THREE WEEKS BEFORE THE END OF THE SEMESTER OF THE ORIGINAL DATE OF GRADUATION. Failure to do this will require a reapplication and repayment of fee.**
