

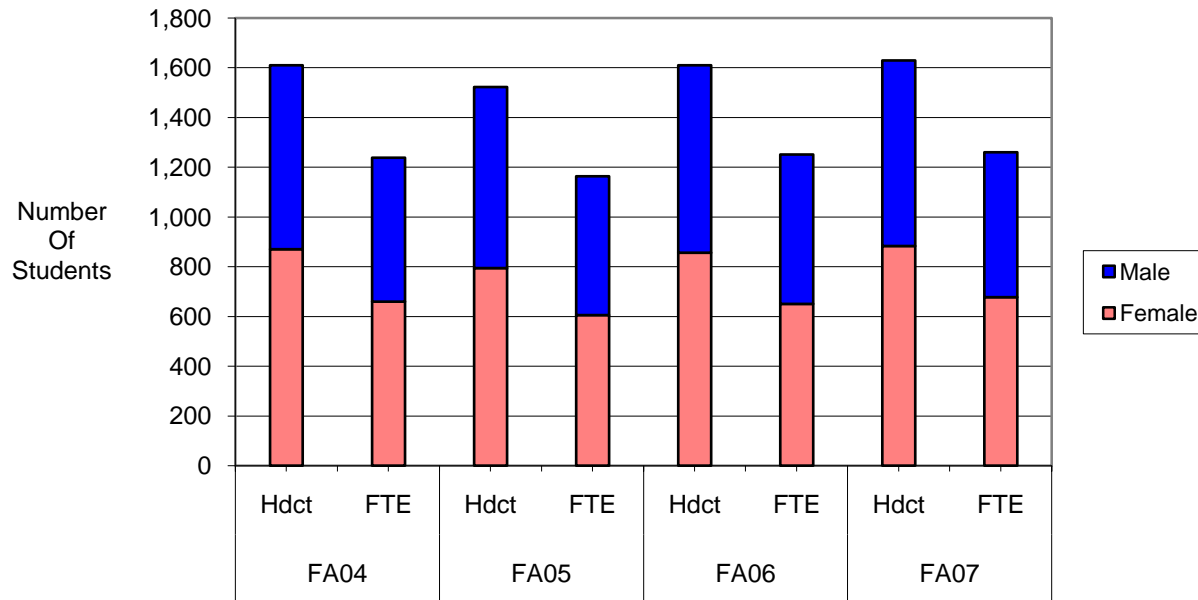

**Graph 1.1: A Four-Year History Of Fall First-Time Freshman Enrollment (Headcount And FTE\*) By Gender**



\*The FTE bar chart represents the proportion of credit hours calculated on a FTE basis (i.e., credit hours/15) taken by female and male students.

A majority of the first-time freshman student body at St. Charles Community College have been female. The female headcount has consistently averaged about 53% over the past four fall terms.

First-time male students tend to have a slightly higher FTE percent than their headcount percent.
