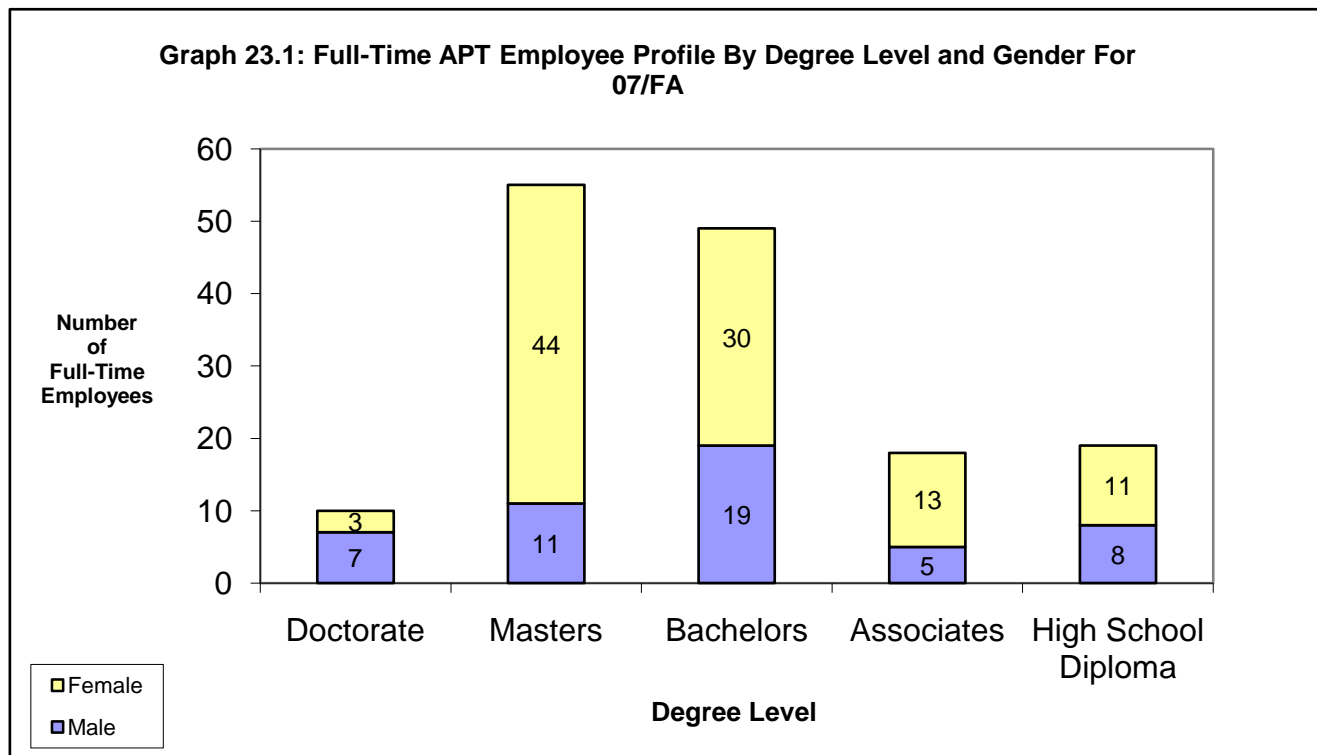

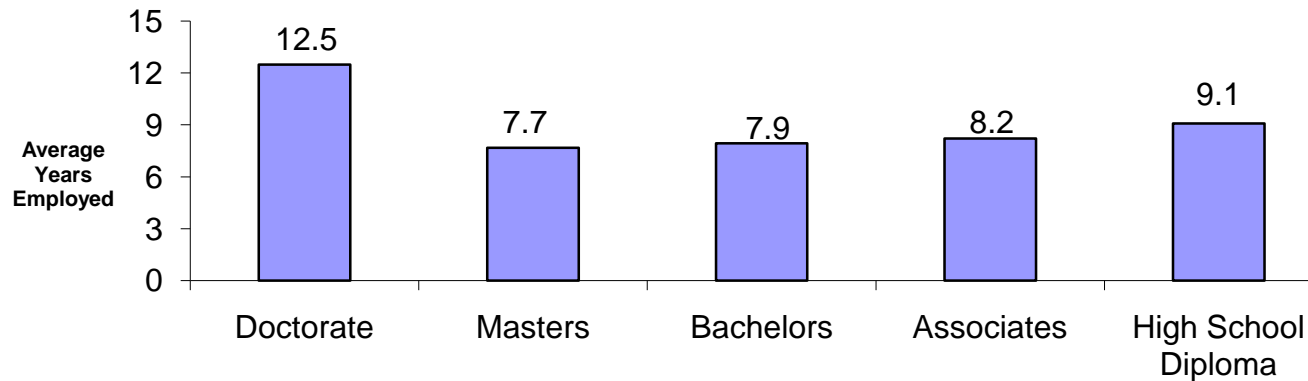

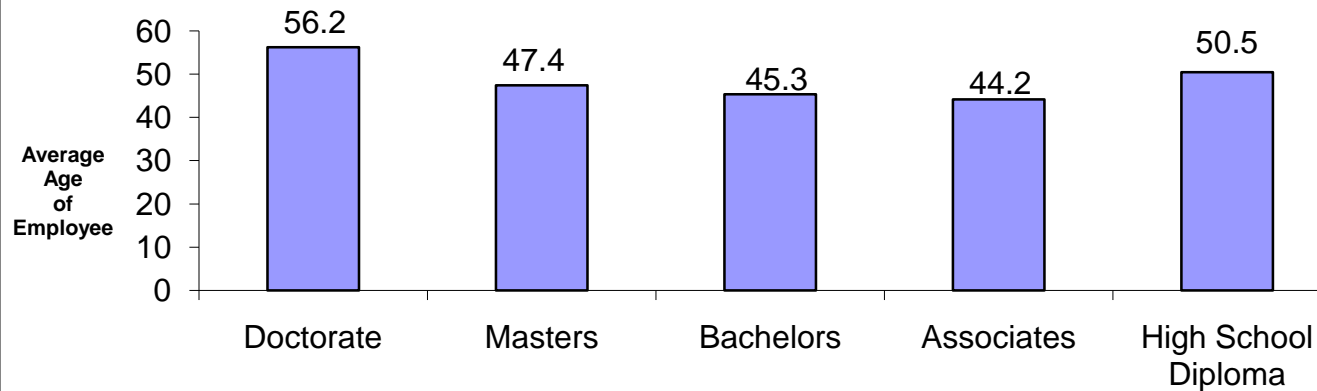
The chart to the left shows full-time APT employees by degree level. Only at the Doctorate level was there a majority of males over females.
