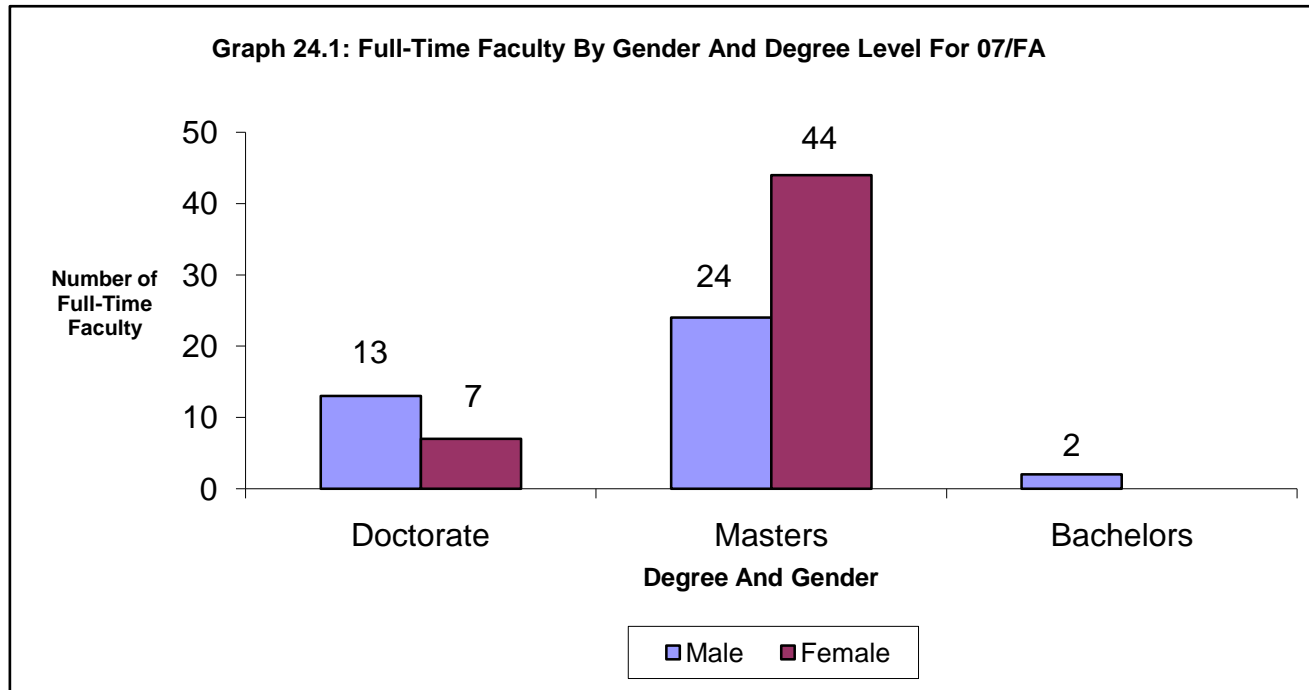

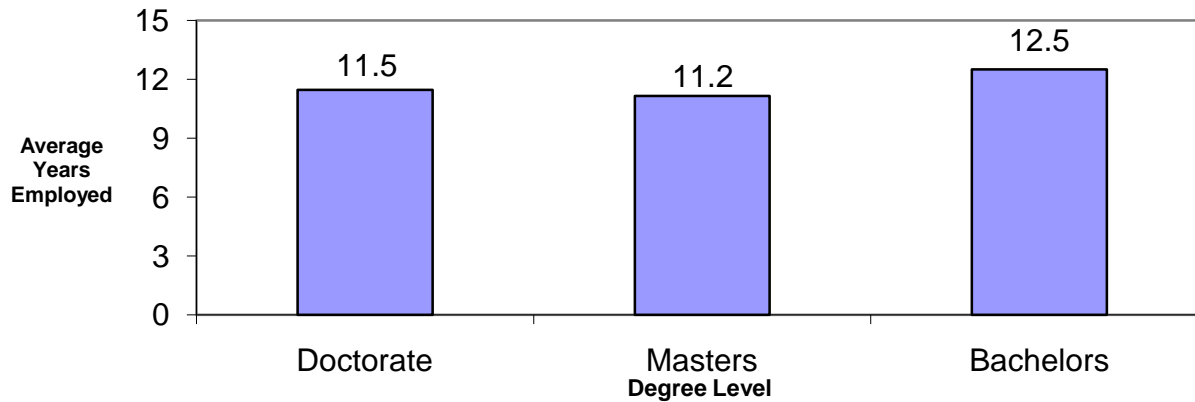

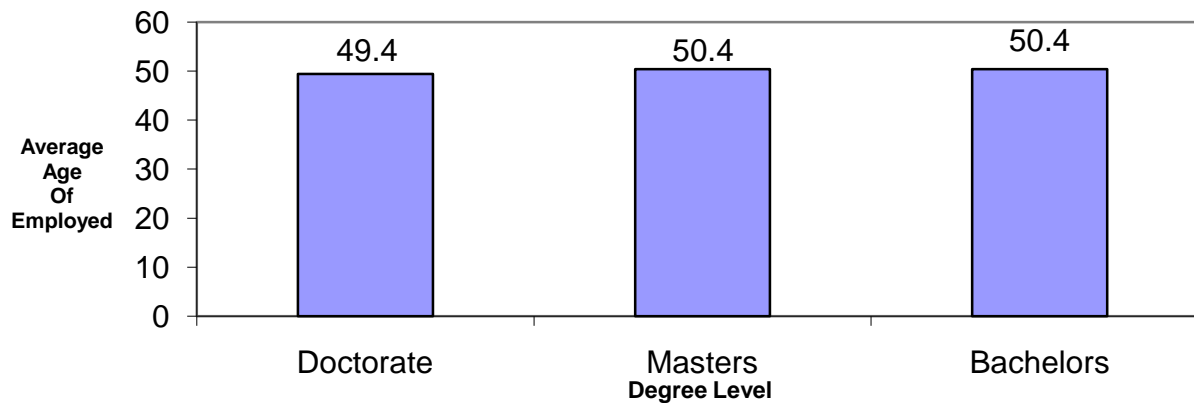
Most full-time faculty either had a Masters or Doctorate degree in 07/FA. Males tend to hold a majority of the Doctorates and females tend to hold a majority of the Masters. Faculty who had a Masters degree averaged 11.2 years of service while faculty with a Doctorate averaged 11.5 years of service.

Graph 24.1 illustrates the gender difference in degree levels. There are 13 males and 7 females who hold a Doctorate degree. In contrast, 44 females and 24 males hold a Masters degree. Two males hold a bachelors degree.

Graph 24.2 shows that the full-time faculty who held a Doctorate degree averaged nearly the same number of service years at SCC as did faculty who held a Masters degree. Faculty who hold a Bachelors degree averaged 12.5 years of service.
