

ST. CHARLES COMMUNITY COLLEGE ACADEMIC TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Note: This application is two sided

The Board of Trustees Scholarship Program is designed for students at St. Charles Community College who have demonstrated an academic aptitude. Recent high school and GED graduates, home schooled, and existing St. Charles Community College students are all encouraged to apply.

The Academic Trustee Scholarship is a tuition waiver that covers the in-district rate per credit hour. Recipients that live out-of-district will need to pay the difference between the in-district and out of district rate per credit hour. Students receiving A+ funds and full SCC athletic awards are not eligible to receive this award. Students receiving federal and or state funding, such as but not limited to Pell, SEOG grant, ACG grant, etc. will have those funds applied to their account first and the Academic Trustee secondary. Recipients will receive this scholarship depending on restrictions of the other program(s) and other expenses.

Recipients must be enrolled in and complete a minimum of (6) credit hours each semester that the scholarship is awarded as well as maintain a cumulative 2.50 GPA. If a student fails to enroll or complete 6 credit hours or their cumulative GPA drops below a 2.50, the student will forfeit his/her scholarship.

The Academic Trustee Scholarship only covers the cost of tuition for up to 72 credit hours. Courses transferred from other institutions or from previous semesters will be considered in the 72 credit hour limit. Students who have completed 72 credit hours are not eligible for the Academic Trustee Scholarship.

Scholarship Award Amount: In-district tuition rate for fall and spring semesters

Application Requirements: Students must complete the front and back of this application as well as provide one of the following to be considered:

- Official high school or SCC transcript indicating a cumulative 3.00 GPA
- Official GED test results indicating a score of 2700 or higher and verification of 12 hours of instruction through a SCC site.
- Official ACT test results indicating a score of 23 or higher.

Renewing Criteria: Scholarship is automatically renewed for up to three additional semesters (excluding summer terms) if a 2.50 cumulative GPA is achieved and at least 6 credit hours are complete.

If a student is awarded the Academic Trustee Scholarship, she must complete and return the statement of intent (that will be provided in the award packet) to the financial aid office by the deadline date or his/her scholarship will be forfeited.

I have read and understand the above information regarding the application and guideline Academic Trustee Scholarship. I understand that not yet been awarded the scholarship and I will be notified 30 days after the deadline date whether or not I will be awarded the Academic Trustee Scholarship. It is my responsibility to provide all of the required documents by the deadline date in order to have a completed application on file and be considered for scholarship.

The Trustee Scholarship Program will cover the cost of tuition at in-district rates for up to four continuous semesters (excluding summer terms). Recipients must complete a minimum of six credit hours each term with a minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA for the award to be renewed. This Scholarship will only cover up to 72 credit hours (preexisting and courses transferred from other institutions will be considered in the 72 credit hour limit).

In order to apply for the Academic Trustee Scholarship you must complete the front and back of this application as well as provide one of the following documents.

- **Official high school or SCC transcript indicating a cumulative 3.0 GPA**
- **Official GED test results indicating a score of 2700 or higher**
- **Official ACT results indicating a score of 23 or higher**

These documents must be *Official*, not copies.

Deadline Date: April 1st (June 1st for any remaining scholarships not awarded from the April 1st deadline). All required scholarship items must be provided by 4:30p.m. on the deadline date. Any missing criteria may disqualify applicant.
