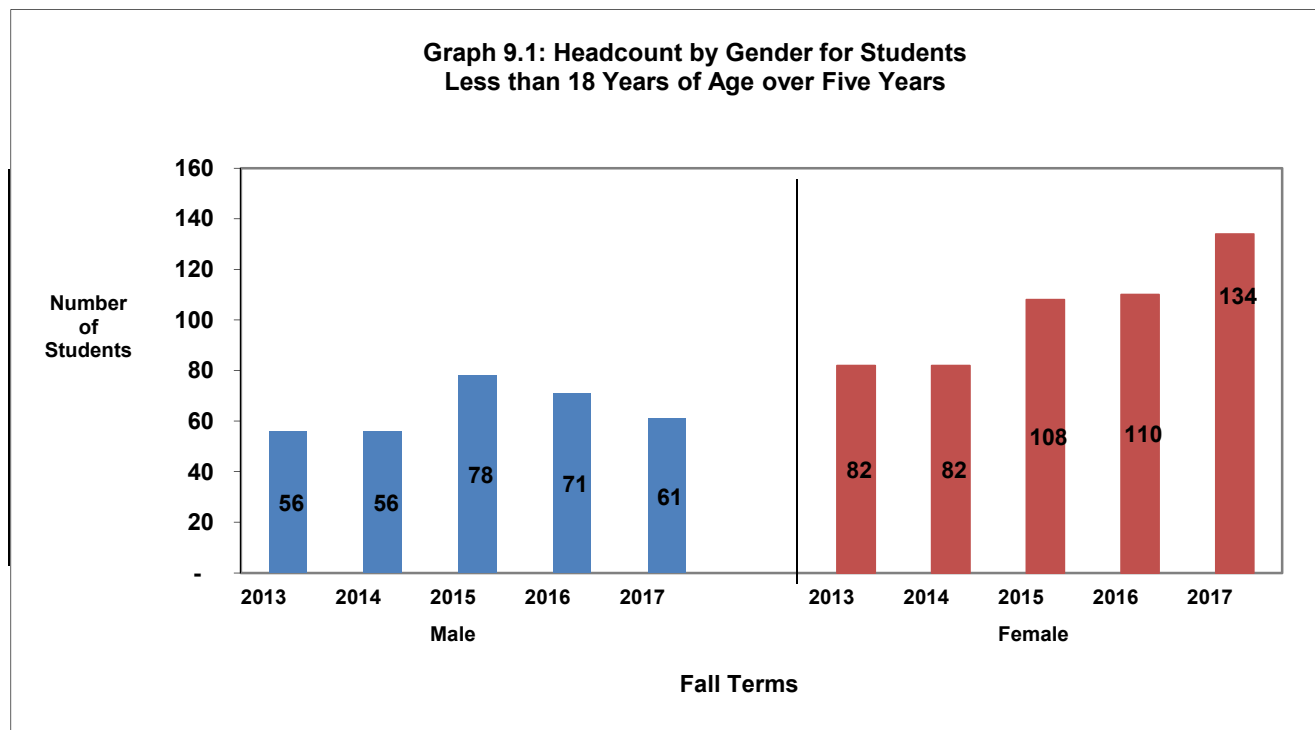

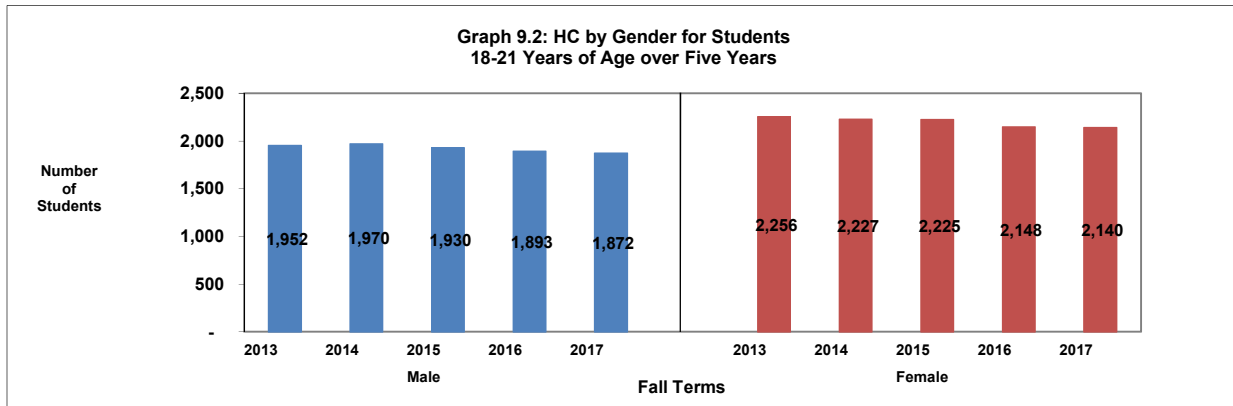

Table 9 shows that St. Charles Community College students are typically age 18-21, which is the traditional age of college students.

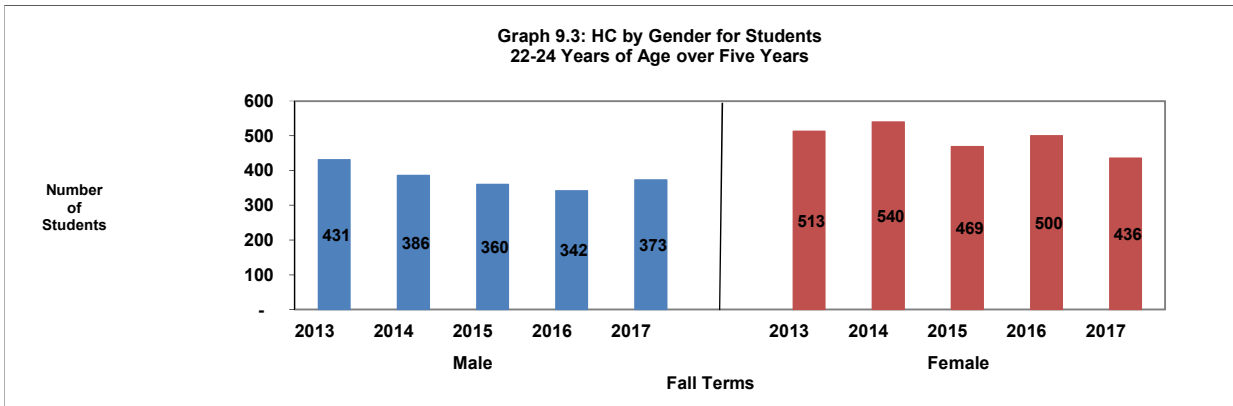
Graph 9.1 shows that the HC for females under the age of 18 has been increasing since 2014. For males, the headcount increased from 2014 to 2015, but has decreased since.

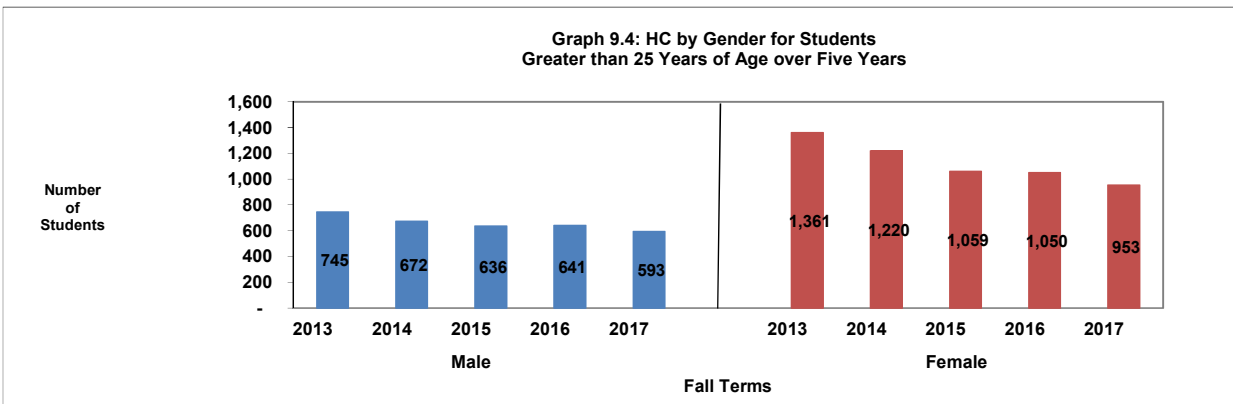




Graph 9.2 shows that in 2017 the HC for females and males age 18-21 decreased.
