

Common mistakes that delay A+ Processing



- You did not file your Federal Application For Student Aid (FAFSA) before June 1.
- You did not sign your FAFSA with a PIN #.
- You did not sign your FAFSA with both a parent and student PIN#.
- The social security number you used when filing your FAFSA does not match the SS# you gave when enrolling at St. Charles Community College.
- The A+ student indicated on their FAFSA that they are "independent" when they are really "dependent" and their parent's information was missing from the FAFSA application.
- You did not respond to any letters sent by our processing department requesting additional information for your FAFSA file.
