

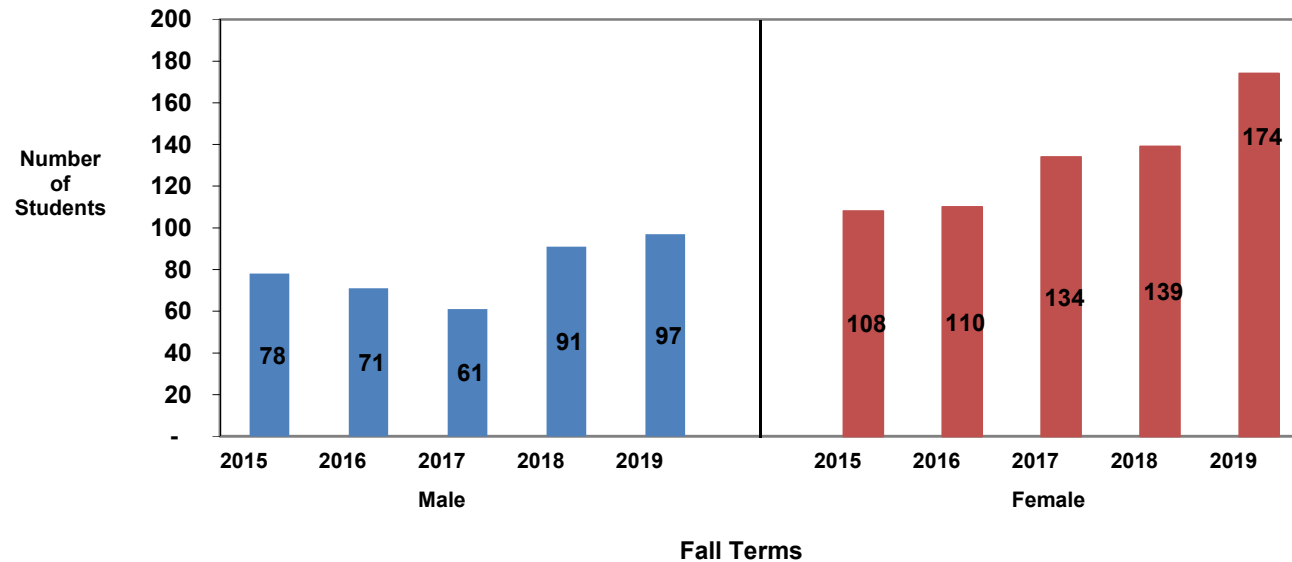

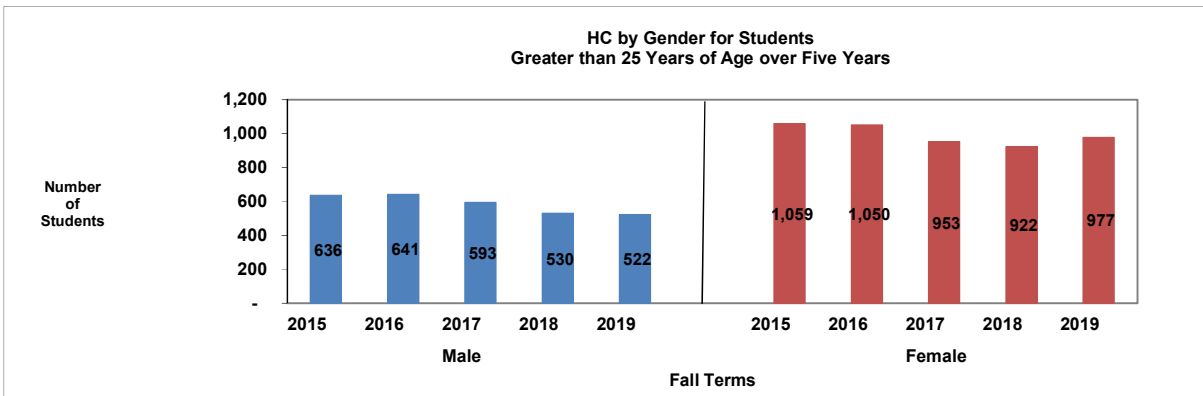
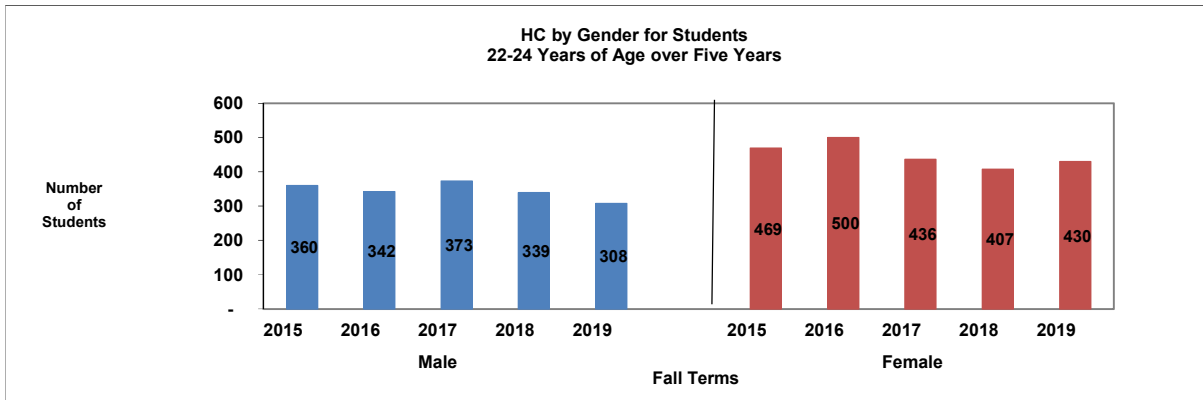
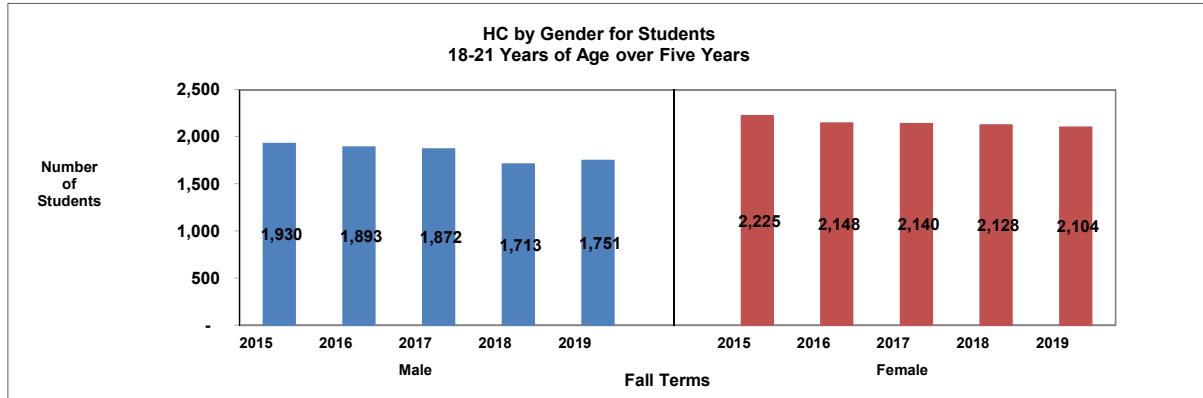
**Headcount by Gender for Students

HC for females under the age of 18 has been increasing since 2015. For males, the headcount decreased from 2015 to 2017, but has increased since.

Since 2015 the HC for females and males age 18-21 decreased.

Since 2017 the HC for males age 22-24 decreased while the female HC fluctuated.

Since 2013, the HC for the 25 and older group has decreased for males, while females saw an increase in 2019 after decreasing since 2015 as well.
