MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

St. Charles Community College and St. Charles County Ambulance District Training Center

St. Charles Community College (SCC) agrees to enter into an articulation agreement with St. Charles County Ambulance District Training Center (SCCAD) for the purpose of recognizing EMS training and National Registry certification in the awarding of college credit toward an associate of science degree in emergency medical science.

- SCC agrees to award 30 credit hours for satisfactory completion of the approved curriculum submitted by SCCAD. The SCCAD EMS program is an 18 month program, consisting of the EMT-B and Paramedic training programs.
- SCC requires proof of passing the National Registry for EMTs EMT-Paramedic cognitive and psychomotor exams in order for SCCAD completers to receive the 30 credit hour transfer award toward an associate of science degree in emergency medical science.
- SCC cannot provide financial aid for students enrolled in the SCCAD training program.
- SCC can provide financial aid for qualified students admitted as degree seeking students and enrolled in classes with SCC.
- SCCAD agrees to update curriculum for their EMS courses annually and to keep SCC up
 to date with information regarding any changes in curriculum.
- SCCAD agrees to provide proof of its State of Missouri accreditation for the EMS program offered through SCCAD
- SCCAD agrees to invite a SCC representative to serve on the SCCAD advisory board.
- SCCAD agrees to provide credentials for state approved instructors teaching in the SCCAD EMS program.
- SCCAD will inform SCC of any changes or updates to their program structure, accreditation or administration.
