AWARD AMOUNT: Cost of tuition for fall and spring terms at in-district rate only

CRITERIA: This is a full-tuition waiver scholarship provided to students who meet the following requirements:

- 3.0 cumulative GPA on your most recent transcript
- Score of 2700 or higher on the GED Exam or score of 68 on HiSet exam
- Score of 23 or higher on the ACT
- Students who are A+ Scholarship Program-eligible and/or have 72 completed hours are not eligible to receive this scholarship.

A+ Scholarship Program »

The Missouri A+ Scholarship Program affords students who have graduated and successfully met the requirements from a designated A+ Missouri high school the ability to earn up to \$189 per credit hour toward tuition for up to four years following high school graduation.
