



SCC Student Demographics Fall 2020 Report

- 62% of SCC students are between the ages of 18-21; 32% are 22 or older (20/FA Census).
- 47% attend SCC part-time (20/FA Census).
- 4% of students attend only evening classes (2% of all credit hours) (20/FA Census).
- 23% are minorities as compared to 10% in St. Charles County (20/FA Census, 2018 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates).
- 38% of students receive some form of financial aid (DHE-14 & Annual Undup File).
- 88% of students work while attending SCC. Of students who work, 56% of students work part-time (30 hours per week or less); 28% work full-time (more than 30 hours weekly); 4% work varied hours (Student Opinion Survey 2019).
- 75% of students are enrolled in Associate of Arts and Science courses; 25% are enrolled in career-technical courses (20/FA Census).
- 84% of the AS and AAS graduates report that they use the skills and knowledge from their SCC degree in their current jobs (180-Day 2020 graduate survey of 2019 graduates).
- 19% of 2020 spring graduates from area high schools attend SCC in the fall (20/FA Census).
- 25% of students receive A+ scholarship funds (20/FA Census).
- 42% of fall semester students re-enroll in SCC one year later (2020 NCCBP, F4, fall 2018 students reenrolled in fall 2019).
- 74% of fall students are from St. Charles County (20/FA Census).
