

## SCC Student Demographics Fall 2021 Report

- 62% of SCC students are between the ages of 18-21; 31% are 22 or older (21/FA Census).
- 46% attend SCC part-time (21/FA Census).
- 3% of students attend only evening classes (2% of all credit hours) (21/FA Census).
- 24% are minorities as compared to 10% in St. Charles County (21/FA Census, 2018 American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates).
- 40% of students receive some form of financial aid (DHE-14 & 21/FA Census).
- 88% of students work while attending SCC. Of students who work, 56% of students work part-time (30 hours per week or less); 28% work full-time (more than 30 hours weekly); 4% work varied hours (Student Opinion Survey 2019).
- 74% of students are enrolled in Associate of Arts and Science courses; 26% are enrolled in career-technical courses (21/FA Census).
- 84% of the AS and AAS graduates report that they use the skills and knowledge from their SCC degree in their current jobs (180-Day 2020 graduate survey of 2019 graduates).
- 22% of 2020 spring graduates from area high schools attend SCC in the fall (21/FA Census).
- About 29% of students receive A+ scholarship funds (21/FA Census).
- 47% of fall semester students re-enroll in SCC one year later (19 (Retention Rates, Feb-2021, IR Portal Page).
- 74% of fall students are from St. Charles County (21/FA Census).
