


St. Charles Community College students are typically age 18-21, which is the traditional age of college students.


The headcount for females and males under the age of 18 has been increasing since 2021.



The headcount for males age 18-21 have been fluctuated. Females have started to decrease compared to 2024.

Since 2021, the headcount for males age 22-24 have been decreasing, while females, having a steady increase.

Since 2021, the headcount of females aged 25 and older has steadily declined, with a rebound in 2025. In contrast, the male headcount in this age group dipped in 2022 but has been rising steadily since 2023.
