CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The St. Charles Community College Board of Trustees met on February 28, 2022, in the Social Sciences Building, Room 2102 (Board Room)

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Board President Lohmar. A quorum was present with the following members in attendance: Board President Shirley Lohmar, Board Vice President Rose Mack, Board Treasurer Mary Stodden, Board Secretary Pam Cilek, Trustee Jean Ehlmann, and Trustee Mike Lissner.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Board President Lohmar led trustees and attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

On a motion by Cilek, a second by Lissner, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the agenda was approved.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES: JAN 24, 2022, BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

On a motion by Stodden, a second by Ehlmann, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, minutes of the January 24, 2022, Board of Trustees meeting were accepted as presented.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Board Treasurer Stodden presented the Treasurer's Report. Cash in bank \$8,082,739; total investments \$67,105,841; tuition and fees received to date \$16,635,561; local taxes received to date \$19,894,706; state appropriations received to date \$6,819,544. On a motion by Ehlmann, a second by Lissner, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Treasurer's Report was accepted.

APPROVAL FOR PAYMENT OF BILLS

On a motion by Cilek, a second by Mack, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board approved payment of bills from the Operating Fund in the amount of \$7,489,422.

STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION REPORT

FACULTY REPORT

Faculty Association President Bryonie Carter reported the following:

- Dr. Rachel McWhorter-Rush, English faculty, is one of 12 in a semester-long, Study Group cohort with the University of Pittsburg Justice Collective, through their School of Education.
- Assistant Professor of English Dr. Joe Baumann's press, Gateway Literary Press, released its first two books in late January. Students enrolled in ENG 203: Publishing Workshop in Spring 2021 helped select the published manuscripts.
- The English Language and Culture Institute welcomed our new students Feb. 16 with a Hot Chocolate Social in the Rotunda. Students enjoyed hot chocolate, marshmallows, and great conversation starters. ESL faculty and the ESL specialist hosted the event, and SCC staff members stopped by to visit with our students.

- Lynne Snyder, Amy Scheers, Jean Deimund and Samantha Stavelly attended the Missouri Thespian Conference held January 21 through January 23.
- The Center Stage production, “Little Women,” ran Feb. 24-27 at the Donald D Shook Theatre.
- SCC’s Professor Emeritus, Kevin Patton presented at the Textbook & Academic Authors Association Conference. Dr. Patton currently serves as President of the Association.

REPORT OF THE COLLEGE PRESIDENT

Dr. Barbara Kavalier reporting on the following activities at the college:

- SCC is excited to continue progress towards developing the new Workforce Technical Training Center near Wentzville.
- SCC Celebrated Black History Month with a series of educational events that served as a reminder to acknowledge and recognize the contributions of black people and to remember to be more inclusive. This year’s theme centered around black health and wellness.
- Students, Community ‘Continue the Conversation’ about race – a discussion about diversity, equity, inclusion and how to create a welcoming environment.
- College for All Kids Summer Camp enrollment opens March 1st.
- Baseball and Softball season began with games in Tennessee at the Saluqi Invitational.
- Women’s History Month in March with a series of events hosted by Student Life.

CIVIC ACTION PLAN

Bryonie Carter provided an update on the Civic Action Plan and Service Learning. The President’s Council approved the Civic Action Plan May 2021. Service-Learning courses continue to see growth in number of sections and participation.

DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENT

Kathy Brockgreitens provided an update on the college’s dual credit enrollment programs. The Early College Academy has now had four graduates from Orchard Farm School District, 11 from the Wentzville School District and one from Wright City School District. In Fall 2017 we had 197 dual enrollments and as of Fall 2021 there was a significant increase to 411.

TUITION AND FEE PROPOSAL

The Board will be asked to review proposed tuition and fees for FY23, with action requested at the next regular meeting. The proposal for FY23 include a \$5 In-District rate increase, with related increases to the Out-of-District and Out-of-State rates; moving Practical Nursing from the Tier 1 tuition rate to the Tier 3 tuition rate; and a \$50 per course technical course fee for Dual Credit/Dual Enrolled students taking courses in tiers 1-3.

BIDS AND CONTRACTS – Action

a. Ratification of AV for Bond Projects

On a motion by Cilek, a second by Lissner, and five “Aye” and one “Nay” votes to carry the motion, the Board ratified the email vote from February 21, 2022 that approved the purchase audio-visual materials and services for the new science labs project and the student services area remodel from CDW Government LLC, Vernon Hills, IL, in the amount of \$648,524.66. *Funding Source: Proposition Community College Bond Proceeds.*

b. Building Kit for CHL

On a motion by Stodden, a second by Mack, and a unanimous “AYE” vote to carry the motion, the Board approved the purchase of a pole barn building kit be awarded to Menards, St. Peters, MO in the amount of \$44,557.52 plus \$4,455.75 contingency for a total of \$49,013.27. *Funding Sources: 2021/2022 Enhancement Grant 75% (\$36,759.95) and 2021/2022 College Match 25% (\$12,253.32)*

c. Police Vehicle Lease

On a motion by Ehlmann, a second by Stodden, and a unanimous “AYE” vote to carry the motion, the Board awarded a contract to Joe Machen’s Ford Lincoln, Columbia, MO in the amount of \$40,564.35 financed through Ford Credit Municipal Finance Program. *Funding Source: FY22 Public Safety Operating Budget*

CLOSED SESSION

On a motion by Stodden, a second by Lissner, and a roll-call vote in which “AYE” votes were cast by Cilek, Ehlmann, Lissner, Lohmar, Mack, and Stodden to carry the motion, the Board entered closed session as allowed by as allowed RSMo 610.021.2 to discuss leasing, purchase, or sale of real estate by a public governmental body where public knowledge of the transaction might adversely affect the legal consideration therefor.

Following the closed session, the public meeting reconvened at 7:13 p.m.
