

## A+ SUMMER SEMESTER RESTRICTIONS

Students cannot use their A+ eligibility as a "visiting student" during a summer only term, if they have been degree seeking throughout the year at another college/ university. The only exception is for enrollment in a summer term, immediately following an A+ student's high school graduation.

If a new transfer A+ decides to attend SCC in the fall term immediately following a summer semester, A+ funding may be considered. Please refer to our "A+ new /transfer student checklist" link.

## Please note:

- Summer is the end of the prior FAFSA filing academic year and that application will need to be completed in addition to the FAFSA for the upcoming academic year, which starts each fall term. All applications will still need to be completed by our deadlines. (Please refer to "A+ deadlines".)
- Due to deadline constraints and heavy volume during the summer months, most new A+ students using benefits for a summer term will be on a reimbursement basis. Existing A+ students, who have been degree seeking at SCC throughout the academic year, will not need to pay upfront.
