

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI-ST. LOUIS**

**Associate of Arts in Business Administration to BSBA-Business Administration, Bachelor of Science in  
Information Systems and Technology (BSIST), and Bachelor of Science in Accounting**

This document specifies in terms for a transfer agreement between The Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University of Missouri-St. Louis (hereinafter referred to as "UMSL") and St. Charles Community College (hereinafter referred to as SCC) and is intended to benefit the students at both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to the awarding of college credit by UMSL for courses successfully complete by students at SCC.

This articulation agreement is intended to prepare SCC students completing the Associate of Arts degree in Business Administration for UMSL's BSBA, BSIST, and BSA degrees.

SCC and UMSL agree that in accordance with CBHE Credit Transfer Guidelines, students may transfer more than 64 credit hours for lower division courses from either Missouri associate degree-granting or baccalaureate degree-granting institutions. Any additional lower division course credits above the 64 credit hours will be accepted in transfer if the credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for an upper division course in the major.

However, please note that students planning to graduate from UMSL College of Business will meet the graduation requirement stating that students must complete at least 60 hours of course credits from an accredited four-year institution.

To insure that the SCC student is ready to enroll at UMSL College of Business at the junior level for BSBA, BSIST, or BA degree program, the student must follow the recommended plan of study attached.

This agreement would be effective with 2021-2022 academic year. The agreement will be reviewed by both SCC and UMSL on a yearly basis and any degree requirement changes or amendments to the attached recommended plan of study must be noted and mutually agreed upon.
