

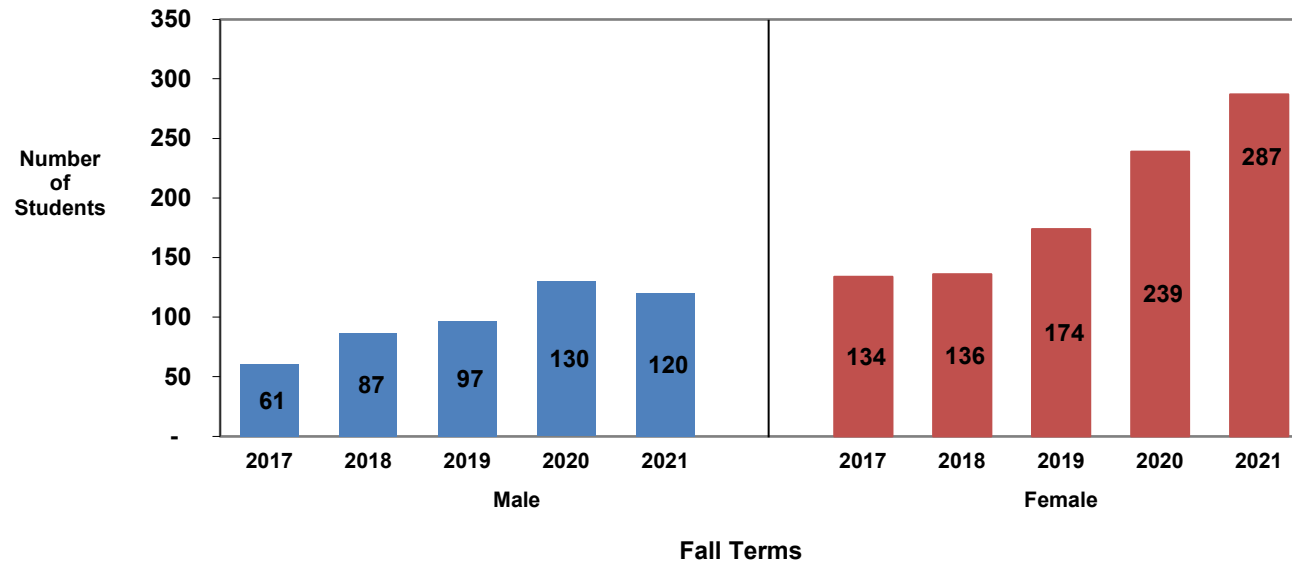

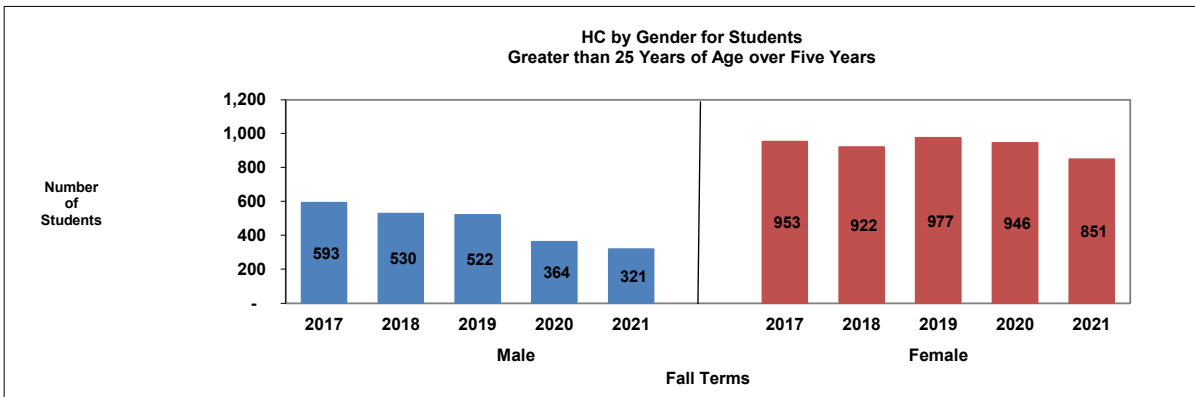
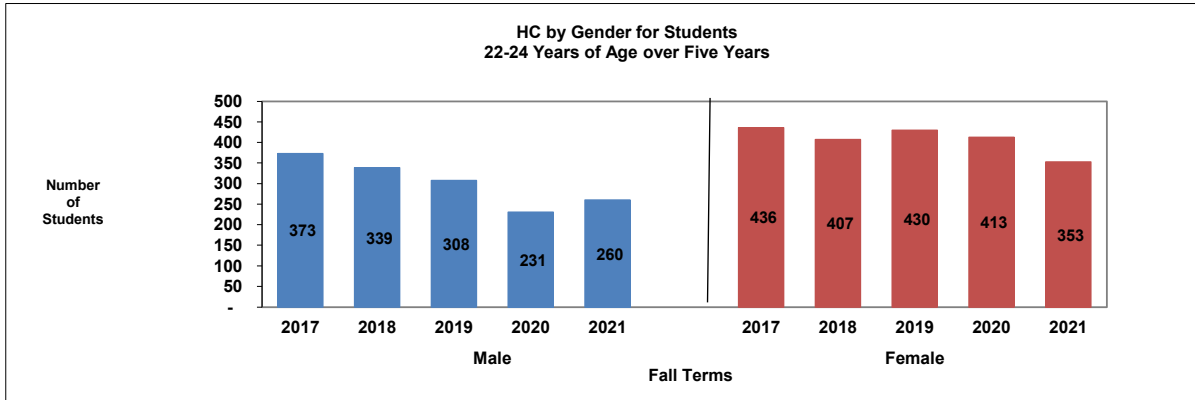
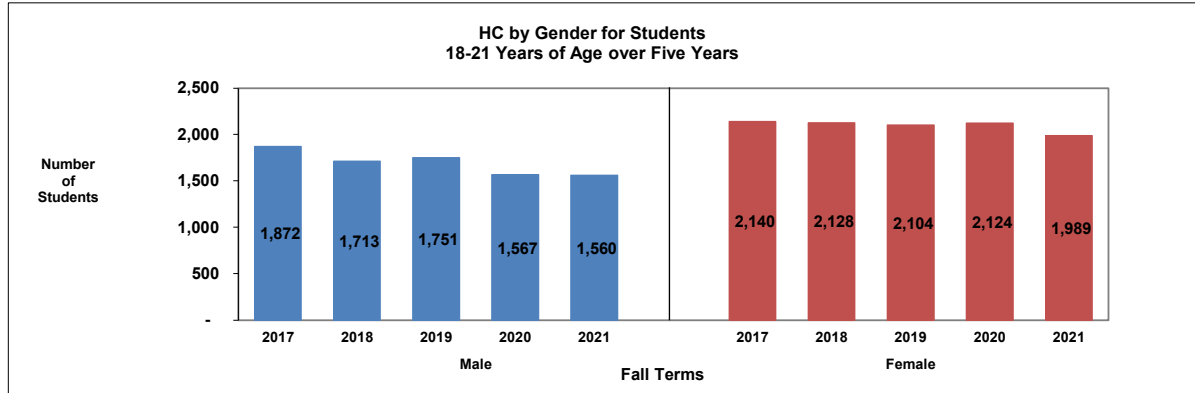
**Headcount by Gender for Students

HC for females under the age of 18 has been increasing since 2017. For males, the headcount has decreased since 2020.

Since 2017 the HC for males age 18-21 have decreased, while females have fluctuated until 2021 resulting in a decrease.

Since 2017 the HC for males age 22-24 increased in 2021, while females, having a steady hold, have recently decreased.

Since 2017, the HC for the 25 and older group has decreased for males, while females saw an increase in 2019 but declined from
