**Graph 9.1: Headcount by Gender for Students Less than 18 Years of Age over Five Years**

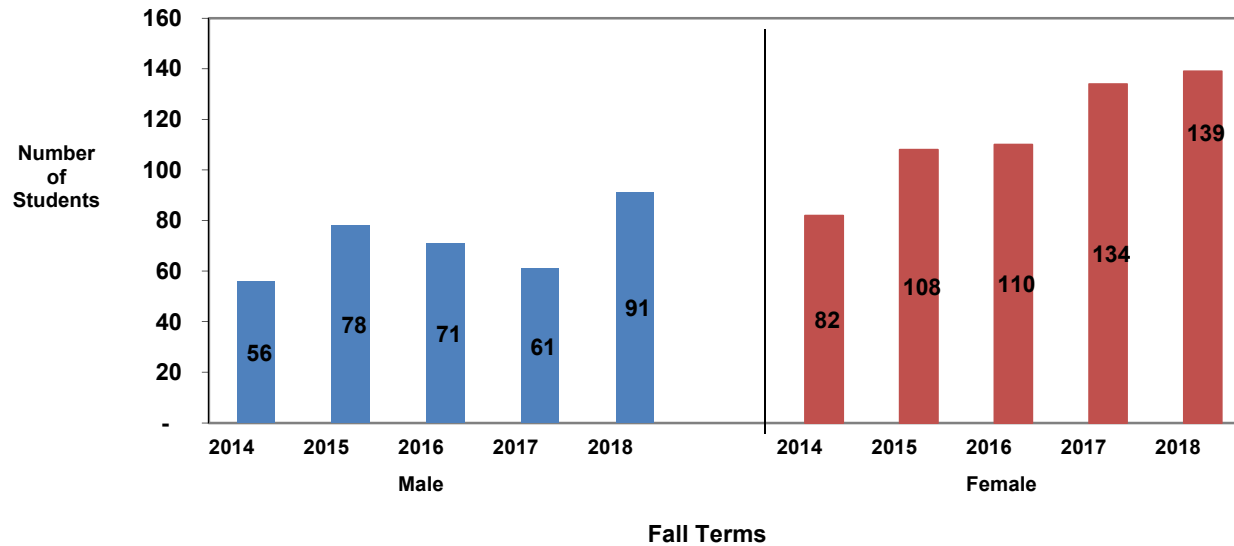
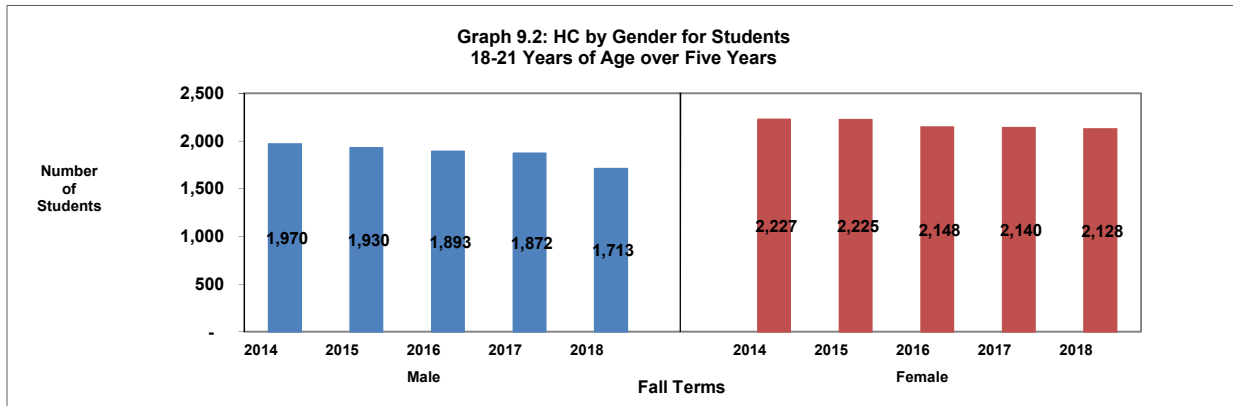
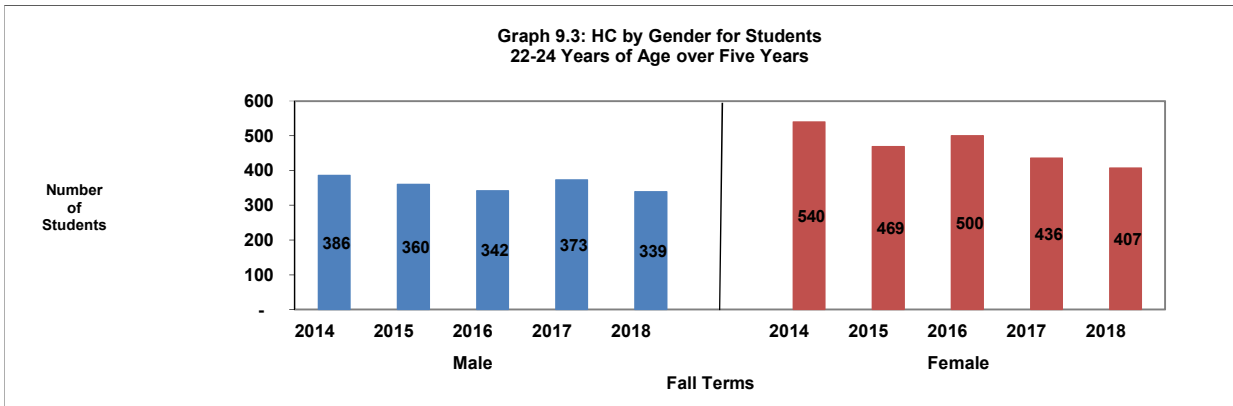


Table 9 shows that St. Charles Community College students are typically age 18-21.

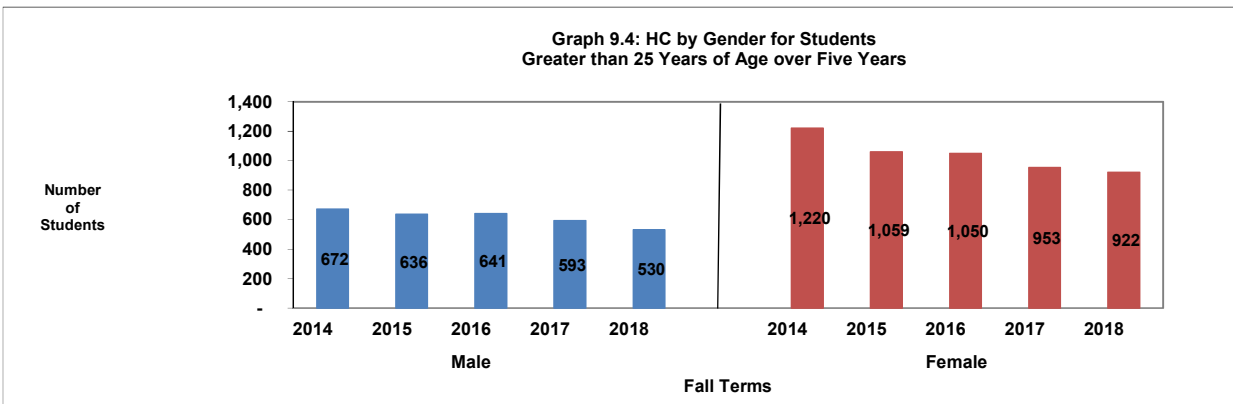
Graph 9.1 shows that the HC for females under the age of 18 has been increasing since 2014. For males, the headcount increased from 2014 to 2015, but was then in the decline until 2018.



Graph 9.2 shows that in 2017 and 2018 the HC for females and males age 18-21 decreased.



Graph 9.3 shows that in 2017 the HC for females age 22-24 decreased while the male HC increased. In 2018, the HC for males and females age 22-24 declined.



Graph 9.4 shows that since 2013, the HC for the 25 and older group has consistently decreased.
