MATH ASSESSMENT APPEAL PROCEDURES

APPEAL INFORMATION

- Visit <u>www.stchas.edu/assessment</u> for test preparation resources.
- A student can appeal one time only.
- A \$10 fee is required for each appeal use the form on the back of this page.
- Students that did not place in a course can repeat the appeal process.
- Students that did not start a course they placed into can re-assess (at no charge) after one year even if they appealed their initial placement.
- Students **MUST** re-assess (at no charge) if it has been at least three years since they last assessed and never enrolled in a math course.
- Any student that is re-admitted after withdrawing and/or failing all coursework MUST re-assess
 (at no charge) if it has been three or more years from the month they withdrew or failed the
 course(s) in question.
- Should you require assistance in meeting academic challenges, the college offers courses in math, reading, study skills and English as well as instructional support services through our Academic and Career Enhancement (ACE) Tutoring Center.
- For accommodations with the placement assessments, contact <u>Disability Support Services</u>, in advance, at dss@stchas.edu or 636-922-8581.

MATH

The Math Department encourages students to appeal their placement when they believe it is incorrect. The student will re-assess using a different form of the original assessment test. Students should spend time reviewing skills needed on the assessment before re-testing. If after appealing you feel that your score does not reflect your current math skills, you may discuss your situation with the appropriate math department Chairperson located in ADM 2242 (636-922-8496). Bring any supporting documents, such as ACT scores, high school transcripts and the assessment report to the appointment. **Once you start a math course, no appeal will be allowed.**
