Initial placement is **Important**.

Initial placement into the math sequence determines how many courses you will need, and the number of semesters needed to complete the required math course for your degree path.

Students are encouraged to review before taking the math assessment.

ModuMath: An Interactive Multi-Media Math Tutorial

ModuMath is an interactive multimedia computer program that offers students a chance to learn and review at their own pace. It consists of user-friendly tutorials with full motion video (not just text). It specifically targets adult learners. The learner can select the areas to review. Each subject is broken into several lessons and each lesson takes about 20 minutes to complete.

ModuMath covers many topics in both developmental math and algebra. It lets each learner set the pace of instruction, offers immediate positive reinforcement, checks for understanding with short quizzes and questions, holds student attention with continuous interaction, and minimizes math anxiety.

The ModuMath program is **free** for any SCC student or any prospective student preparing to take the academic assessment.
