CONDITIONAL ADMISSION AGREEMENT **MISSOURI VALLEY COLLEGE AND ST. CHARLES COMMUNITY COLLEGE (SCC)**

This agreement does not guarantee admission to a particular degree program at MVC. Missouri Valley College (MVC) and St. Charles Community College (SCC) wish to enter into an agreement of conditional guaranteed admission to benefit both Missouri Valley College and St. Charles Community College in the recruitment of international students, and to assist international students in their educational planning in the completion of a Bachelor's degree. The following understandings will guide this effort, until modified or amended.

1. Admission. MVC and SCC agree that:

Under this agreement, MVC will admit qualified current and prospective international SCC students into the College. MVC agrees to define qualified international SCC students as those who have:

- a. Completed or will complete any degree of SCC and MVC, including:
 - Associate of Arts,
 - Associate of Arts and Science,
 - Associate of Arts in Teaching
 - Associate of Science,
 - Associate of Fine Arts,

This agreement does not guarantee admissions for students completing an Associates in Applied Sciences degree.

- b. Achieved a minimum cumulative collegiate GPA of 2.00 in all transferable academic coursework at SCC; coursework taken at other colleges, however, will not automatically transfer to MVC and must be reviewed.
- c. Demonstrated English proficiency by successful completion of EN 130 or equivalent.
- d. Submitted a complete transfer application

2. Recruitment and Marketing. MVC and SCC agree that:

- a. SCC will inform prospective international students of this partnership;
- b. Both institutions will advertise this partnership on their website;
- c. SCC will provide MVC with the contact information of students who choose this guaranteed conditional admission;
- d. SCC has permission to mail a letter authored by MVC to all international students who select this program informing them that they have been conditionally admitted to Missouri Valley College;
- e. Promotional plans and materials regarding conditional admissions will be subject to approval by each institution.
- f. SCC students should meet with an MVC Transfer Specialist for academic advising during their studies at SCC. This will help ensure that they are taking appropriate courses.

3. Term and Termination.

- a. This agreement will be valid when it is signed by both the MVC Representatives and the SCC Representatives.
- b. The term of this agreement shall be for three academic years, beginning the date of signing by the final signatory below. This agreement will renew automatically unless both parties decide otherwise.
- c. This memorandum of understanding and agreement may be modified by mutual agreement of both Parties.
- d. Amendments to this agreement must be in writing and approved by the designated representative of each institution. Amendments to the memorandum of understanding and agreement must be made with no less than sixty days notice to all Partners involved.
- e. Either party may terminate this agreement for convenience by giving written notice to the other party's designated representative at least 60 days prior to the commencement of a new academic semester. This Agreement can be terminated at any time by mutual written agreement.
- f. All notices concerning this agreement shall be in writing, and will be considered to have been given at the time of receipt of notice by the other partner.
- g. Termination will not affect articulation in effect prior to the effective date of the termination. In event of a termination of this agreement, the parties agree to act in good faith and use their best efforts to make arrangements that enable currently enrolled students to complete their program of study.



4. Indemnification and Insurance. The parties agree to defend, indemnify, and hold each other harmless from and against any loss, claim, or damage, including without limitation the cost from any reasonable attorneys' fees and/or litigation, to the extent it arises or is alleged to arise from the negligent acts or omissions of their respective officers, employees, students or agents in the performance of their duties under this agreement.
5. Independence of the Parties. The Parties are independent contractors. Nothing contained in this MOU will constitute either Party the agent, partner, or legal representative of the other Party for any purpose, or constitute the Parties as partners or joint ventures. Neither Party has any right, power, or authority to create any obligation or responsibility on behalf of the other.


