MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS

The meeting of the St. Charles Community College Board of Trustees was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Board President Cilek. A quorum was present with the following members in attendance: Pamela Cilek, President; Shirley Lohmar, Vice President; Rose Mack, Treasurer; Mary Stodden, Secretary; Jean Ehlmann, Trustee; and William Pundmann, Trustee.

Also present were Dr. Barbara Kavalier, College President; Dr. John Bookstaver, Vice President for Academic Affairs and Enrollment Management; Donna Davis, Vice President for Human Resources; Heather McDorman, Vice President for Marketing and Student Life; Todd Galbierz, Vice President for Administrative Services; Chad Shepherd, Chief Information Officer; and Julie Parcel, Executive Assistant.

Audience members included staff members Frank Barrow, Jeff Drake, Bradley Egberts, Rob Jones, Susie Rubemeyer, Betsy Schneider, and Sharon Schreiber; and community members Kurt Bahr, Arnie Dienoff, and Sherri Espinoza.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Board President Cilek led the Board, staff, and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES: MAY 20, 2019, PUBLIC MEETING

On a motion by Pundmann, a second by Mack, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, minutes of the May 20, 2019, Board of Trustees regular meeting were accepted as presented.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

On a motion by Lohmar, a second by Stodden, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the agenda was approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Mack presented the Treasurer's Report. Cash in bank \$5,072,854; total investments

\$22,260,000; tuition and fees received to date \$16,139,861; local taxes received to date \$18,566,909; state appropriations received to date \$8,627,022. On a motion by Stodden, a second by Ehlmann, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Treasurer's Report was accepted.

APPROVAL FOR PAYMENT OF BILLS

On a motion by Pundmann, a second by Lohmar, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board approved payment of bills from the Operating Fund in the amount of \$2,478,707.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Board President Cilek called for public comments. St. Charles County Director of Elections Kurt Bahr announced that his office is looking forward to providing support for the trustee election on April 7, 2020. The St. Charles County Election Authority is currently recruiting election judges and working to relocate polling places in order to alleviate security and parking concerns at elementary schools.

REPORT OF THE COLLEGE PRESIDENT

Dr. Kavalier presented highlights of the institution's most recent accomplishments as included in the monthly newsletter.

FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET AMENDMENT

On a motion by Ehlmann, a second by Lohmar, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board approved an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2019 General Fund budget to reflect the actual financial activity of the past year to account for variances in local property tax revenues, tuition, state funding, and investment income.

BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020

On a motion by Mack, a second by Pundmann, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board approved the Fiscal Year 2020 budget as presented for a total amount of \$60,094,176.

NEW BUILDING

Todd Galbierz presented information on location, size, and potential for workforce and technical training program delivery and growth at a commercial property located at 25 Guenther Boulevard in St. Peters.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES POLICIES AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES MANUAL REVISIONS

Proposed revisions to Article V.03 (P-204) Procurement of Goods and Services; Article V.04 Procurement of Construction Services and Materials; and Article V.05 (P-226) Auxiliary Enterprises were presented for review. Changes include new purchasing authorization thresholds, authorization for emergency purchases, and revised fees for the Child Development Center. The Board will take action on proposed revisions at the next regular meeting.

BIDS AND CONTRACTS

Cisco SMARTnet for Network Computing

On a motion by Pundmann, a second by Lohmar, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, a contract was awarded to World Wide Technology, St. Louis, MO, in the amount of \$31,815.67 for the annual Cisco SMARTnet, Licensing, and Software Support Services required for the College's Telephony, Emergency Responder, and Phone Gateway system. *Funding Source: Current Operating FY 2019/2020 Network Computing*

CLOSED SESSION

On a motion by Pundmann, a second by Lohmar, and a roll-call vote in which "AYE" votes were cast by Cilek, Ehlmann, Lohmar, Mack, Pundmann, and Stodden to carry the motion, the Board adjourned to closed session as allowed under RSMo 610.021.2 to discuss leasing, purchase, or sale of real estate by a public governmental body where public knowledge of the transaction might adversely affect the legal consideration therefor; RSMo 610.021.3 to discuss hiring, firing, disciplining or promoting of particular employees by a public governmental body when personal information about the employee is discussed or recorded; and RSMo 610.021.9 to discuss preparation, including any discussions or work product, on behalf of a public governmental body or its representatives for negotiations with employee groups. Trustee Ehlmann left the closed session at 8:00 p.m.

After discussion in these areas, on a motion by Pundmann, a second by Lohmar, and a roll-call vote in which "AYE" votes were cast by Cilek, Lohmar, Mack, Pundmann, and Stodden to carry the motion, the Board reconvened to open session.

APPROVAL OF INTERIM CONSULTING CONTRACT

On a motion by Pundmann, a second by Mack, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board authorized College administrators to enter into a contract for interim financial aid services as needed.

RATIFICATION OF EMAIL VOTE FOR RETIREMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM

On a motion by Stodden, a second by Lohmar, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board ratified the June 7, 2019, email vote to approve execution of the Voluntary Early Separation Incentive Program.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY

On a motion by Pundmann, a second by Stodden, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board passed a resolution to purchase property located at 25 Guenther, St. Peters, Missouri, pending removal of all contingencies.

MEMORANDUMS OF UNDERSTANDING

On a motion by Lohmar, a second by Stodden, and a unanimous "AYE" vote to carry the motion, the Board approved an addendum to the full-time faculty Memorandum of Understanding.
