A.S. IN NURSING TO BSN/MSN ONLINE DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM IN NURSING

AGREEMENT

St. Charles Community College (SCC) students who transfer to the Chamberlain BSN (Bachelor of Science) Degree /MSN (Masters of Science) program will be considered for admission at Chamberlain when the following materials have been submitted:

1. A completed application form
2. Official college transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, including a transcript documenting the Associate of Science in Nursing Degree at SCC with a minimum CGPA of 2.0 for BSN and CGPA of 3.0 or greater in RN to BSN coursework for MSN
3. Minimum grade of C in all nursing courses from any previous nursing education for BSN
4. A copy of the registered nurse license

Upon receipt and verification of these items, SCC nursing graduates shall be granted admission to the Chamberlain BSN program.

Highlights of the Agreement include:
