2. Pass the Franklin University Algebra Competency Test;
3. Take Fundamental Algebra (MATH150) at Franklin University; or
4. Transfer in Fundamental Algebra (MATH150) or higher (College Algebra, Calculus, Finite Math, Discrete Math, etc., but not Statistics**)

**Statistics will not waive the Algebra Competency Requirement unless the course has been approved for your school. Please see your Advisor.
